- This app understands that the seller may be using Bundles on Shopify and may have normal individual level items on Amazon , and hence we also have a mapping of bundles on Shopify to individual items on Amazon FBA.

Many of the much needed though simple features are built in on this app


- Mapping between bundles

Step 1 – How to register on Amazon Marketplace Webservice (MWS)

Go to the [User Permissions](#) page in Seller Central and log into your Amazon selling account as the primary account holder.

Under **Amazon MWS Developer Access Keys**, click the **Visit Developer Credentials** button.

On **Developer Central** page, under **Are you a software developer building applications using MWS?**, click the **apply for access here** link, and then follow the instructions on the Amazon MWS Developer Registration and Assessment form.
